

## Flysk by Nobuyuki Kurose - Video - DOWNLOAD

A borrowed ring flies into the new and sealed Frisk case.

Borrow a ring from the spectator, and hold it in your left hand. Take out the sealed Frisk from your rear pocket, and tap on it...the ring is gone. Tear the film and open the Frisk case. The spectator's ring lies in it.

After the ring disappeared, you can show the the Frisk case in every angle before tearing the film up. Everyone can see it's sealed and there is no way for the ring to get in. Nevertheless, the borrowed ring reappeared in that case. Incredible.

The vanish of the ring is so beautiful that one might think it requires special gimmick. No, it doesn't. Just get a brand-new Frisk from anywhere you can. All you need is a 3-minute processing and you are ready to vanish any borrowed ring.

If you think it troublesome to prepare new Frisk, save it for special events. Used Frisk case is good enough for performance in casual occasions. That way, you can reset it in an instant, and repeat as many times as you need.

It's an ideal trick with a strong effect and a compact form that is suitable for opening.
