Mindprint

The spectator holds a completely blank business card in their hands. They think of the name of anyone - absolutely anyone. When they open their hands and turn the card over, the impossible has happened: the name that existed only in their mind is now written on the card. A personal, intimate, unforgettable miracle.

Psychic Strike

One of the cleanest and most devastating demonstrations of card prediction. You hand the deck to the spectator and turn your back. They cut wherever they like, slip the chosen card into their pocket, and return the rest to the box - no switches, no duplicates, no electronic devices. You turn around, look at them,

and simply state the exact card they hid. Simple. Direct. Impossible.

Pulse Code

Imagine revealing the exact day and month someone was born just by feeling their pulse. With Pulse Code, it's not just possible - it's poetic. The spectator doesn't write, speak, or give a single clue. You place your fingers on their wrist, pretend to concentrate... and then reveal their full birthdate. An intimate moment that feels like pure telepathy.

Future

The spectator thinks of a two-digit number-or any freely chosen information. Suddenly, their phone rings. The audience answers - and the voice on the other end is you... from the future. Your "future self" talks to the spectator and reveals exactly what they were thinking, without them saying a single word. A moment that turns mentalism into a live, science-fiction experience.

Just Your Imagination

One of the best-kept secrets of my repertoire - revealed here for the first time. The spectator thinks of someone important and secretly writes the name on a piece of paper. You not only reveal the name with surgical precision... but then the paper vanishes. The pen vanishes. As if nothing ever happened. The thought existed for a brief moment, was revealed, and then erased from the universe. The audience is left wondering: did it really happen, or was it just imagination?

These aren't routines. They're fractures in logic.
Moments where the audience stops asking how...
...and starts asking what's real?

WHY THIS IS DIFFERENT

Other books teach tricks.

Psicose teaches **madness**.

It's not about learning another billet technique - it's about weaponizing it into something that leaves your audience doubting their own memories.

It's not about a marked deck - it's about turning paper and ink into psychological landmines.

This is not a safe book.

It's not designed to make you look clever.

It's designed to make your audience lose their grip on reality.
