Generations of entertainers have amused audiences of children and adults with the art of hand shadows, using only a light source and their own two hands to form immediately recognizable profiles of people and animals. These quaint illustrations depict many different types of shadows, from swans, rabbits, and other animals to historic figures and fictional characters.
