

Stranger's Gallery by John Bannon - Trick

Stranger's Gallery by John Bannon John Bannon's incredible color-changing deck routine has become a modern-day classic, and once you've seen the impact this effect has on an audience, combined with the minimal amount of sleights necessary you`ll know why.

Effect

From a blue-backed deck, the performer removes three face-down cards from three different places. A fourth card is selected. Each of the three initial cards are shown to match the selected card exactly. The performer remarks that the only way the trick would be possible is if the four cards came from four different decks. Accordingly, the backs of three cards change from blue to black, yellow and white, leaving four cards with four different colored backs!
