The shark won the first two rounds-then lost the next three, just as Pascoe predicted before a single chip was drawn.

Included with the **Equalizer Chips** is **The Pascoe Prediction**, a fully scripted routine where your spectator plays the loan shark. They might win the start, but you've already written how it ends.

## **The Stargate Protocol**
