- **Creativity Theory:** in which Julio Montoro will introduce you to his Creativity Dissociation theory, which will help you to understand how to make your brain work towards creating new magic tricks.
- **Everyday Carry Magic:** in which Montoro will explain 7 effects using high-quality gimmicks to carry with you in your pocket all day.
- **Impromptu Magic:** as every good Spanish magician, Julio will show you how to smart impromptu magic using cards and objects.
- **Social Media Magic:** in this section you will learn how to create highly visual gimmicks to do top social media magic that will also be used in real live situations.

EFFECTS:

- **Manila** - The first creation of Julio Montoro that was a sold-out 10 years ago, now re-imagined with a modern plot and gimmick.
- **Slowration** - The most visual card restoration ever created used within a modern looking routine that will fool many magicians.
- **Child's Play** - A freely named card matches 100% with a drawn card the magician has since the beginning. (With the blessings of Roddy

McGhie)

- **The Fortune Teller** - The origami toy we all used in the school now serves as a forcing device to force **ANYTHING** you want!
- **Quarantine** - Montoro's version of Paperclip by Jay Sankey, with a nice looking gimmick that will allow you to do an awesome signed card routine. (This gimmick is 100% different to the Organic Switch Box by Julio Montoro, which is gimmicked to do a 100% clear switch. Quarantine is like the little brother of the Organic Switch Box).
- **Peek Device** - A peek device that will allow you to get the information from a written business card in an **AWESOME** way to read your spectator's mind. The best part is that the gimmick will be hold by the spectators without them feeling anything strange.
- **ReCorner** - A beautiful torn and restored effect in which the corner of the card will change color before being restored.
- **Sandwich Club** - Montoro's three phases sandwich routine that has been blowing magician's minds since 2017.
- **Carmen's Triumph** - A devious gimmicked deck to perform the clearest triumph **EVER** done before.
- **El Tirachinas** - One of Montoro's most funny effects that will make a smile appear in every magician's face after seeing this!
- **The Safest Card** - An impossible puzzle to keep secret information inside that your spectator will not be able to open.
- **Double Haunted** - A version of the haunted deck that will allow you to produce two cards visually with a single hook up. **Manila** - The first creation of Julio Montoro that was a sold-out 10 years ago, now re-imagined with a modern plot and gimmick.
- **Perspective** - A visual eye candy for your social media viewers in which you will use the perspective of the objects to change reality.
- **Dorito Bite** - The coin bite performed by top TV magicians now with a Dorito!
- **Smiley Meal** - Created for a TV special, you can make appear a McDonald's happy meal inside an empty box in a highly visual way.
- **Mr. Monopoly** - Visually change a monopoly bill into a real one and give it away instantly.
- **The Pile** - Transform a pile of decks into flat envelopes just by turning around (credits to Will Tyrrell and his Vanishing Point).
- **The Hole** - Create an awesome astronomical illusion with a post-it pad and a black hole... I MEAN... a sticker ;)
