He simply asks the spectator to shuffle and cut the deck as many times as they wish. When they are ready, the spectator stops and turns over the first card that chance has placed on top of the deck. Then prediction will match...

This effect is one of many possible with this method, which is as crazy as it is daring, yet incredibly effective when done right. This booklet is here to give you all the keys you need to perform miracles like this yourself.
