

Mat-Rix Stamps by Claude Rix

A special Matrix, with stamps!

The original version of Claude Rix's "**Stamp Matrix**"

Mat: a mat is used to perform the trick

Rix: Claude Rix is the author of the trick

Mat-Rix: It's a kind of Matrix

Stamps: Stamps are used

Mat-Rix Stamps: A special matrix with stamps, by Claude Rix

Effect:

The magician places four stamps on the close-up mat.

These are displayed in a square pattern, two red stamps are placed on two diagonally opposite corners, and two green stamps are placed on the other ones.

Two of the stamps are covered with playing cards.

The four stamps come together one by one under one of the cards, through the mat!

A green stamp goes first, then a red stamp, and finally the second green stamp.

All four stamps are now together!

Strong points:

- Common material, but completely unusual for a magic trick
- A highly original Matrix
- Different-colored stamps make the trick even more incomprehensible!
- Very easy to perform
- Very visual
