

Mental Epic - Wood - Bühnentrick

A board is shown, divided into six compartments arranged in two rows: three at the top and three at the bottom. The mentalist announces that he will be able to read the minds of three spectators randomly selected from the audience.

The first spectator is invited to think of the name of a distant relative. While they reflect, the mentalist writes something in the first top compartment of the board, then covers it with a panel so that no one can see the writing. Immediately afterward, the spectator reveals the name out loud, which is then written in the corresponding lower compartment, visible to the audience.

The tone of the conversation shifts, and a second spectator is involved, asked to think of a city where they would like to go on vacation. As before, the mentalist writes his "prediction" in the second top compartment, covers it with a panel, and then, after hearing the answer, writes the name of the city in the space below.

Finally, the mentalist announces that he will write the value and suit of a playing card. After doing so and covering the third top compartment, he approaches a third spectator and invites them to choose a card at random. The card is shown to the audience, and its value is written in the corresponding lower compartment. At this point, the mentalist removes the panels covering the top compartments one by one. To the audience's amazement, **the words he wrote earlier match exactly** the answers given by the three spectators. A moment of pure magic that leaves everyone speechless and triggers a round of applause!

- The board is carefully crafted from wood. With the panels inserted into the compartments, it measures 33.5 cm (13,18") x 26.5 cm (10,43") x 2 cm (0,78").
