You can set the height and control the exact moment from a wireless remote. Oh, you want a hands-free way to fire the pen? This also comes with a bicep strap to let you shoot the pen out with empty hands. For safety, there is also a double-locking mechanism to make sure E:JECT only fires when it is meant to.
