The card is a mismatched design front and back. The torn edges can be seen on the outside edges of the card. And all four signatures are STILL ON the card.

Reform 52 comes with 52 gaffs meaning it is now twice the of any previous releases in this range. Every card from a regular deck is possible meaning all you need is reform 52 gaffs, plus a regular deck.
