

## Mucha Playing Cards by 52 MUSÉE - Standard edition

Enhanced by holographic craftsmanship, vibrant and colorful lights weave a dreamy backdrop. The women in the foreground appear with sharper contours and captivating expressions. Their elegant faces and graceful poses remain the focus, not overshadowed by the interplay of light and shadow. Against the hazy yet dazzling background, they exude an aura of mysterious allure.

On the front of the box, the window of art shows Gismonda, the work that made Mucha famous, while on the back of the box you can see Zodiac, one of the most commercially sensational works that was published in Feathers, an important platform for art magazines.

The protagonist of The Zodiac is a beautiful young woman with golden, “fusilli”-style curly hair, shown in profile. She wears a Byzantine-style headdress and jewelry, adorned with zodiac symbols, and is set against Mucha’s signature circular patterned background, surrounded by intricate leaf-shaped decorations.
